VISITING INS – WHERE TO PARK

Parking at INS

We have 4 parking spaces on the forecourt in front of the INS building at 82 Hampton Road.

Please note that INS as a charity is unable to provide transport, but there is space for Dial-A-Ride vehicles and private taxis to drop off and pick up from our forecourt.

Parking nearby

All the roads local to INS, from Chertsey Road to Strawberry Hill, are in a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ). This prohibits parking by non-residents from, Monday to Friday between, 10:00am - 4:30pm

Blue Badge holders can park on Hampton Road in the paid bays, on single yellow lines. Double yellow lines if not causing an obstruction.

Richmond Borough residents – If you have a Richmond Card or a RingGo cashless parking account, you can park for free for the first 30 minutes.

With the Richmond Card, you will need to get a parking ticket from the machine located outside ATS Euromaster Tyres at 48 – 50 Hampton Road (near the Prince Albert Pub). If you want to park for longer than 30 minutes, you can still use your Richmond Card to get a discount and then pay the difference. If you have the RingoGo parking app, the machine number you need is 5357. For more information about RingGo, please see London Borough of Richmond website at: https://www.richmond.gov.uk/services/parking/parking_machines/ringgo

If neither of the above apply to you, you will need to buy a parking ticket.

You can purchase a pay and display parking ticket from the machine located outside ATS Euromaster Tyres at 48 – 50 Hampton Road (near the Prince Albert Pub).

The charges are:

For 1 hour - £1.50

For the maximum of 2 hours - £2.90

Please note that the maximum stay is 2 hours and you cannot return for one hour after parking
